DESCRIPTION:

Presented annually to ***at least one*** senior who most emulates Mr. Miller as demonstrated by his or her participation in extracurricular and community service activities. Mr. Miller was the first *Principal of Maine-Endwell Senior High School*. In his personal life and in his commitment to the new high school, he exemplified the value of dedication to school and community. He encouraged academic excellence, discipline and dedication to one's peers. Applicants should have *at least a B average, demonstrate participation in extracurricular, community/public service and school activities, and be accepted into a 2- or 4-year college/university program in the fall of 2024 leading to a career in public service.* Application can also be found at: www.m-e-alumnischolarship.com

- Up to 500 Word Essay
