Applicants should have ***at least a B average, demonstrate participation in extracurricular, community/public service or school activities.***

PLEASE NOTE: Completed application must be returned directly to the secretary in the Guidance Office no later than 5/1/2024.

REQUIREMENTS: ***COMPLETED APPLICATION WHICH INCLUDES:**

- Transcript
- Two Letters of Recommendation, **NOT** a relative
- College/University Acceptance Letter
- List of Extracurricular, Community/Public Service or School Activities and Work Experience, if any.
- *Up to a 500 Word Essay*

- Describe your interests in one or more of the following areas: **Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math** or related field (such as accounting or economics), otherwise known as **STEAM**, and how you intend to pursue those interests. (**up to 10 points**)
- Who or what was your inspiration? (**up to 10 points**)
- Where do you see yourself in 5 years and how do you see yourself giving back to your community in the future. (**up to 10 points**)
