extracurricular and community service activities. Mr. Miller was the first *Principal* of *Maine-Endwell Senior High School*. In his personal life and in his commitment to the new high school, he exemplified the value of dedication to school and community. He encouraged academic excellence, discipline and dedication to one's peers.

Applicants should have at least a B average, demonstrate

participation in extracurricular, community/public service and school activities, and be accepted into a 2- or 4-year college/university

program in the fall **leading to a career in public service.**
